1. **Policies**

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with recognised accounting principles.

2. **Designated Funds**

In prior years the Association has received funds to be applied against specific projects. During the year to 30th September 2010 and during the prior period no such funds were received and no designated funds are held at the balance sheet date.

3. **Fixed Assets**

The Association has acquired display equipment at a cost of £1,234, a computer at a cost of £1,295, a digital camera at a cost of £130 and a notice board at a cost of £539. All these assets were acquired by way of grant funding and are therefore shown at a nil value in the balance sheet.

Additionally, the Association has acquired a gazebo out of unallocated funds and this asset is shown in the accounts at cost less a provision for depreciation, written off over a 4 year period.
